KI3 aims to accelerate progress in reducing malnutrition by strengthening access to and utilization of existing implementation knowledge and experience, and by generating support and funding for practical and impactful implementation research at country and program levels. This side event introduces KI3's five strategies and generates strategy-specific roundtable discussions with stakeholders on ways to move them forward.
