A Decade of Action to End All Forms of Malnutrition

On Thursday November 29th, 18:00-19:30

At the Centara Grand & Bangkok Convention Center (Room: World Ballroom A), Bangkok, Thailand

Our food systems are shaped by a variety of drivers and policies, and they are currently not providing to ensure healthy, affordable and sustainable diets for all. From food production to consumption and waste disposal, the different sectoral policies including agricultural, economic, trade, environmental and international development create (dis)incentives for production of particular types of food. Food environments determine what foods will reach the consumer and which ones will be consumed.

The focus of this side event is to provide an opportunity to assess – two years into the **UN Decade of Action on Nutrition (2016-2025)** – what the progress is of implementation of nutrition commitments by governments, the UN and other actors to address the double burden of malnutrition. The lead UN agencies will report on the progress made in different policy domains, including health, food, and social protection systems; and on the accountability mechanisms that have been established. It will also be the opportunity to launch the FAO/WHO resource guide for making commitments.
